





An extension with a difference

This allows for the maximum amount of light to enter the room below and gives the lantern a neat modern look.

Not only do Wendland Lanterns look stylish, they are also designed with many thermal features to help stop condensation. This feature is very important if the room below is to be used as a kitchen where changing heat levels can be a problem.

Clip-fit features and the unique ridgeLOCK mean that Wendland Lanterns are fast to fit and go together perfectly every time.

Another option to bring light into an extension or orangery is the Wendland Flat Skylight.

The unique, simple design features edge-to-edge glass with no visible bars – meaning that when you look up, all you see is glass and the sky above. The Wendland Flat Skylight lends itself to either modern or heritage projects as it is so simple in design and sits equally well in a modern flat roof extension or a more traditional orangery.

Wendland Flat Skylights don't just look great, they are also very

advanced in terms of their thermal performance, meaning that they will help to ensure a warm and cosy room below. The U-Value of the flat skylight is just 1.2 and this can be further enhanced by pairing it with the optional insulated kerb. The kerb also helps to avoid condensation, something that is very important in rooms such as kitchens or bathrooms where heat levels can change quickly.
